

Beef Tallow BSE Statement

BSE (Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy) Statement

To Whom It May Concern,

We confirm that the Beef Tallow supplied by Bath and Body Base Ltd is manufactured exclusively from cattle sourced from Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland. Northern Ireland (as part of the United Kingdom) and the Republic of Ireland are both officially recognised by the World Organisation for Animal Health (WOAH) as having negligible BSE risk status. This classification reflects the comprehensive controls in place to prevent, monitor and manage Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE).

All cattle used in the production of our beef tallow originate from approved establishments operating under official veterinary supervision of the Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA) and the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine (DAFM). Comprehensive controls are applied throughout the supply chain, including:

- Full traceability of cattle and raw materials
- Official ante-mortem and post-mortem veterinary inspection at slaughter
- Mandatory removal and disposal of Specified Risk Material (SRM) in accordance with applicable UK and EU legislation
- Strict feed controls prohibiting the use of processed animal proteins in ruminant feed
- Ongoing national BSE surveillance and monitoring programmes

Based on the origin of the raw materials and the statutory controls implemented by the competent authorities in Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland we are satisfied that the risk of BSE associated with this product is considered negligible.
